On Sunday 7.6.44 I examined at the hospital ward Dr. Israel Scheib.

I found the patient in a plaster-jacket in strong reclination. The lower back as far as visible showed large bruises. The right hip was slightly sensitive. There were no signs of paralysis. The patient complains over pains in his right leg.

The X-ray photos I got from Tel-aviv showed a severe fracture of the 4th lumbar spine with considerable displacement, photo taken through the plaster shows the spine in fairly good position.

The patient suffered a serious injury. The treatment with plaster-jackets \_ which must be changed every two months - will take about 10 - 12 months. Afterwards he has to wear a leather corset for about two years.

I would advise to take new X-ray photos through the plaster-jacket.
